

## Employee Fit Test Respirator Reminder

Please work with your supervisor to ensure the following questions have been addressed prior to beginning work that requires respiratory protection. It is important that you have an adequate supply and/or plans for reuse to ensure your continued health & safety, and your employer is responsible for providing you with appropriate respiratory protection (29 CFR 1910.134).

- Have my supervisor and I have determined how many respirator(s) I need for typical use?
- If I have a limited number of respirators, my supervisor has or will be communicating and training me on reuse practices?
- Does my supervisor have a stock or future supply of respirators for my use?
